



## INSPECTION SUMMARY

**Project Name:** Greenstone Gold Mine

**Proponent Name:** Greenstone Gold Mines

**Inspection Date:** November 13-14, 2024

### Project Description:

Greenstone Gold Mines is constructing, operating, and will be decommissioning, and reclaiming an open-pit gold mine and on-site metal mill located approximately five kilometres south of Geraldton, Ontario, at the intersection of Highway 11 (Trans-Canada Highway) and Michael Power Boulevard. As proposed, the gold mine would have an ore production capacity of 30,000 tonnes per day, and the metal mill would have an ore input capacity of 30,000 tonnes per day. Please note that this project was formerly known as the Hardrock Deposit Project.
